Fall in love with NORWOOD PARK

Norwood Park is a unique Country House like no other. Steeped in nearly 1,000 years of history, this property has seen the turn of many centuries.

The first weddings held at Norwood Park were in Saxon times beneath our centuries old Oak Trees that range across our vast grounds. Since the 1970s, our weddings have moved into the house and onto the lawn.

For nearly 150 years, Norwood Park has remained a private home in which the Starkey Family continue to reside when it is not in use by guests. Just as we care for the family when they are home with us, we also care for our guests as individuals and valued friends.





EXCLUSIVELY *yours*

Unlike many venues, when you book Norwood Park - the House, the Grounds and the Gallery are yours exclusively from 12 noon until 12 midnight. Apart from you and your guests, the only other people on site will be your Event Manager and our staff.

This offers our couples and their guests the extraordinary opportunity to stay and celebrate in this memorable, eccentric Country House in complete privacy.

Choose Norwood Park as your venue and together we will create the wedding occasion you have always dreamed of.





THE House

Norwood Park (Northwode) was first mentioned in the inquisition of Archbishop Neville's property in 1388. After the Civil War, Parliament put many episcopal lands up for sale including Norwood Park. In 1649, Edward Cludd (Master General of London) purchased Norwood Park for £965, and resided in the 'pretty little brick house'. At restoration, Norwood Park was returned to the church, but Cludd remained a tenant for life.

In the 1760s, Norwood Park was leased by John Sutton, who pulled down Edward Cludd's house and erected the present mansion you see today. In 1778, his brother Richard Sutton successfully sought an act of parliament enabling him to exchange his Easthorpe estate for ownership of Norwood Park.

Norwood Park has remained privately owned since and has enjoyed the residence of many families including Marquis of Carmarthen (Duke of Leeds), Lord Edwin Hill and Mr Dahswood Fane throughout the years.

Today Norwood Park is the home of the Starkey Family. It has been thoughtfully restored not as a Hotel but rather as a stunning, eccentric, opulent and stylish Country House. You'll find whimsical original wallpapers, restored Georgian fireplaces, 200-year-old rugs and reams of original Vanity Fair albums.



THE Gardens


The Grounds of Norwood have a history dating back to medieval times when they formed part of a series of deer parks.

In the 17th Century when the House was rebuilt; formal gardens, a lime walk, middle pond and ice house were all developed.

Norwood Park has been home to the Starkey Bramley Apple Orchard for over 100 years. Fruit growing began at Norwood Park over 100 years ago in 1910, when John R. Starkey (MP for Newark) planted a Bramley Apple Orchard.

Today, together with your Wedding Photographer, you can wander through the Grounds and Gardens to discover our beautiful orchards, a Cricket Ground, lake, ponds, Icehouse, Lime Walk and so much more.





THE Gallery

Originally a Stables and a Coach House, today these buildings have been transformed into an English Palladian style set of Reception rooms with seated dining for up to 180 guests.

The Georgian era is often referred to as The Age of Elegance and the most important element in Georgian interiors is perfect proportion alongside carefully balanced colours.

The Gallery follows these rules with decorative features including vast doorways, white walls, ornate mirrors and enormous gilded chandeliers.

The Gallery leads to the fixed Marquee designed to include a permanent bar, dancefloor and stage together with access via several French doors to the private courtyard.

1. Your Private Viewing by Appointment

At your Private Viewing, one of our Event Managers will give you a guided tour around the House, Gallery and Gardens, together with our Bedrooms and Suites.

You can discuss the Wedding Day you are hoping for including styling, food, music, flowers and so much more.

2. Provisional Booking

After your successful Private Viewing your Event Manager will look to identify and agree the key details with you for your Wedding Day including date, menus, guest numbers, budget and more.

Based on this information, she will put together a bespoke quote tailored to match your requirements.

3. Your Wedding Booking

Once you have decided that Norwood is the perfect place to hold your Wedding and we have agreed a date and quote, you will sign our Booking Contract and pay your deposit.

From that point forward you may book an appointment at Norwood Park as many times as you choose to finalise details of your Wedding.

Please note

A damage deposit is added to your main invoice as security for any damage caused by you or your guests. This will then be refunded after inspection of the property subsequent to your wedding.

Additional bedroom costs are only applicable when booking bedrooms in the East and West Wings of Norwood Park Country House.

When you book your day at Norwood Park, you hire the House, Gallery and Gardens in their entirety, our venue hire fees reflects this commitment to total exclusivity. All our venue hire costs are inclusive of VAT.

Indoors or Outdoors? The choice is yours at Norwood Park.

Norwood Park is licensed to hold both Civil Ceremonies and Partnerships in the Drawing Room seating up to 75 guests or the Gallery seating up to 120 guests.

If you dream of an outside wedding, we are also licensed to hold a ceremony under the Gazebo for up to 150 guests.

We ask that all couples arrange for their ceremony to commence from 1.30pm onwards. To make this arrangement, you will need to contact the Nottinghamshire Registrar directly by calling



Norwood Park can sleep up to 47 overnight guests throughout the Suites and Bedrooms in a combination of Single, Double, King, Super King and Emperor beds.

For families staying at Norwood Park, we have three Z Beds available for use in selected Suites and Bedrooms in the Main House. These are suitable for children under the age of 12.

All our suites and bedrooms include breakfast within the room prices. Breakfast is served between 8.00am and 9.30am each morning in the Dining Room.

Guest access to the suites & bedrooms is from 1pm and the House closes at 10.30am the next morning promptly.



THE Bridal Orangery

Our Bridal Orangery is the perfect place to begin your special day at Norwood Park. With natural light and a fresh breeze from the French Doors opening up to the terrace, Brides can feel relaxed whilst they get ready.

Our Bridal Prep room is ideal for Brides who want to spend time with their family and bridesmaids before the Wedding. The Orangery has full-length mirrors, two dressing tables with lighting and power access as well as ample seating for six guests.

Brides also have the option to add on a pre-wedding brunch catering package which consists of Classic English Sandwiches and a glass of Champagne.
